## APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR CANADIAN APPLICANTS

### Eligibility

Students are selected for their academic talent, passion for learning and they must be proficient in English. Target age range is 14-17, and students must have completed grade 8 in the US system.

### Requirements:

2. Non-refundable application fee of USD \$100.00
3. School Report Cards/Transcripts of Current Year and Previous year
4. Recommendation Letter from a current academic teacher of the school that the student is currently attending
5. Standardized Test Scores copy, if applicable. Students who have been attending schools with English as the medium of instruction for less than 3 years must show evidence of their English proficiency by submitting results of any of the following test scores - SAT, SSAT, TOEFL, IELTS others.
6. Interview: All Vancouver applicants will be invited for a face-to-face interview. Applicants outside of Vancouver will be given a skype interview.

### Program Details:

**Dates: August 8-20, 2017**

**Fees: US\$6,200.00**

It includes housing, meals, field trips, academic program and airport transportation. It also includes a three day non-residential Opus Academy Preparation Program in Vancouver prior to the institute focusing on team building, cross-cultural communication, and character & leadership development.

The fee excludes airfare, visa, medical/ travel insurance, etc.

## Payments:

1. Application Fee (non-refundable) of **US\$100.00** should be submitted along with the application by the following method:
